#Not to be missed

Pontevedra has a very beautiful historic city centre that is unknown to the majority. We recommend strolling around its narrow streets and pavement cafés in its squares. Rent an audio-guide in the municipal tourist office, if you want to learn more about what you see.

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Monastery of Poio

#Historic

An enormous monastery with great views of the Ria of Pontevedra. Its magnificent cloister and large “hórreo” (stone granary) stand out.

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Sanxenxo—Portonovo

#Inevitable

Not a lot to see except strolling along its promenade, visiting the yacht club, its shops and enjoyed the inappropriately called Galician Marbella. Portonovo is famous for its ray “caldeirada” dish.

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A Lanzada Beach

#Feeling

The sea breeze and waves of A Lanzada beach: tour the isthmus of A Lanzada. Explore one of Galicia’s most emblematic beaches along its wooden walkway. An enormous car park where you can leave your car.

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O Grove—La Toja Island

#Recommended

A very pleasant trip around the isle of La Toja. There are countless options for sailing around the “ria” (estuary) in a catamaran, featuring tasting of mussels and Albariño wine.

Impressive views of the isthmus of A Lanzada, in which this geographical feature clearly stands out.

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
