## **Pontevedra**

#### **#Not to be missed**

Pontevedra has a very beautiful historic city centre that is unknown to the majority. We recommend strolling around its narrows streets and pavement cafés in its squares. Rent an audio-guide in the municipal tourist office, if you want to learn more about what you see.

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## **Monastery of Poio**

#### #Historic

An enormous monastery with great views of the Ria of Pontevedra. Its magnificent cloister and large "hórreo" (stone granary) stand out.

#### #Inevitable

Not a lot to see except strolling along its promenade, visiting the yacht club, its shops and enjoyed the inappropriately called Galician Marbella. Portonovo is famous for its ray "caldeirada" dish.

## #Feeling

The sea breeze and waves of A Lanzada beach: tour the isthmus of A Lanzada. Explore one of Galicia's most emblematic beaches along its wooden walkway. An enormous car park where you can leave your car.


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#Recommended
